This overview of C++ presents the key design, programming, and language-technical concepts using examples to give the reader a feel for the language. C++ is a general-purpose programming language with a bias towards systems programming that supports efficient low-level computation, data abstraction, object-oriented programming, and generic programming. Introduction and Overview The C++ programming language provides a model of memory and computation that closely matches that of most computers. In addition, it provides powerful and flexible mechanisms for abstraction; that is, language constructs that allow the programmer to introduce and use new types of objects that match the concepts of an application. Thus, C++ supports styles of programming that rely on fairly direct manipulation of hardware resources to deliver a high degree of efficiency plus higher-level styles of programming that rely on user-defined types to provide a model of data and computation. - College has full-fledged training and placement department. We are conducting In-House and external agency Soft Skill training for all our 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year students.
- Apart from the training provided during the regular course curriculum, the college also provides an extensive training program during the vacation period after the pre-final year exams to prepare the students for the recruitment process in their final year.
- The college has been a frontrunner in campus recruitments with major companies, both from the IT and Core sector. This chapter describes an overview of research findings on physical activity and health. The accompanying box provides a summary of these benefits.

Benefits of being active regularly:

- Increases FLEXIBILITY and MOVEMENT and improves JOINT MOBILITY.
- Improves CO-ORDINATION, MOVEMENT and BALANCE – helps to reduce the risk of falls and INJURY.
- Strengthens BONES, MUSCLES and JOINTS – lowers risk of developing OSTEOPOROSIS or JOINT PROBLEMS such as Arthritis.
- Helps to stabilize BLOOD PRESSURE, BLOOD SUGAR and CHOLESTEROL levels.
- Helps to maintain your WEIGHT – reduces BODY FAT.
- Reduces risk of various diseases – including CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE (CVD) and some CANCERS.
- Helps to prevent and manage mental health conditions such as DEPRESSION and lowers STRESS and ANXIETY.

- How Bengaluru got its world famous alias names of 'Silicon Valley', 'IT city', 'Garden city' and how good Bengaluru is for education were justified. Also expressed how Bengaluru turned into an investor's paradise.



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

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
